

ST CATHERINE'S COLLEGE GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS 2011

St Catherine's College expects to be able to award the following Graduate Scholarships with effect from October 2011:

Alan Tayler Scholarship: one Graduate Scholarship of £5,000 per annum, tenable for up to three years whilst the recipient is liable for University and College fees, for students from outside the United Kingdom who are, or will be reading for an Oxford University DPhil degree in the Mathematical Institute in October 2011. **Closing date: Friday 11 March 2011.**

C C Reeves Scholarship: one Graduate Scholarship of £2,500 per annum, tenable for up to three years whilst the recipient is liable to pay University and College fees, and is for students who are, or will be reading for an Oxford University research degree (DPhil or MSc by Research) in October 2011 related to Physical Geography (particular preference will be given to topics related to quaternary environments, arid systems and geochronology). **Closing date: Friday 11 March 2011.**

College Scholarship (Arts): two Graduate Scholarships of £2,000 per annum, tenable for up to three years whilst the recipient is liable for University and College fees, and is for students who are, or will be reading for an Oxford University research degree (DPhil, MLitt, or MSc by Research) in the Arts (Humanities Division and Social Science Division) in October 2011. **Closing date: Friday 11 March 2011.**

College Scholarship (Sciences): two Graduate Scholarships of £2,000 per annum, tenable for up to three years whilst the recipient is liable for University and College fees, and is for students who are, or will be reading for an Oxford University research degree (DPhil, or MSc by Research) in the Sciences (Mathematical, Physical and Life Sciences Division and Medical Sciences Division) in October 2011. **Closing date: Friday 11 March 2011.**

Glaxo Scholarship: one Graduate Scholarship of £1,500 per annum, tenable for up to two years whilst the recipient is liable for University and College fees, and is for all students who have a confirmed place on the Oxford University 2nd BM commencing 2011 and any St Catherine's students who will commence the accelerated graduate entry medicine course in 2011 or commenced the 2nd BM or accelerated graduate entry medicine course prior to 2011. **Closing date: Friday 11 March 2011.**

Great Eastern Scholarship: one Graduate Scholarship of £2,000 per annum, tenable for up to three years whilst the recipient is liable to pay University and College fees, and for Indian nationals who are, or will be reading for an Oxford University research degree (DPhil, MLitt, or MSc by Research) in October 2011. **Closing date: Friday 11 March 2011.**

Leathersellers' Company Scholarship (Sciences): two Graduate Scholarship of £3,000 per annum, tenable for up to three years whilst the recipient is liable for University and College fees, and is for graduates of European (including UK) universities who are, or will be reading for an Oxford University research degree (DPhil, or MSc by Research) in Biochemistry, Chemistry, Computing, Earth Sciences, Engineering Science, Materials Science, Mathematics, Physics, Plant Sciences, Statistics or Zoology in October 2011. **Closing date: Friday 11 March 2011.**

Light Senior Scholarship: up to eight scholarships of £350 per annum, tenable for one year whilst the recipient is registered for an Oxford University graduate degree or diploma, for graduate students of the College who registered during or before the academic year 2010-2011. **Closing date: Friday 11 March 2011.**

Overseas Scholarship: two Graduate Scholarships of £2,000 per annum, tenable for up to three years whilst the recipient is liable for University and College fees, and is for to students from outside the European Union who are, or will be reading for an Oxford University research degree (DPhil, MLitt, or MSc by Research) in October 2011. **Closing date: Friday 11 March 2011.**

Random House Scholarship: one Graduate Scholarship of £2,000 per annum, tenable for up to three years whilst the recipient is liable for University and College fees, and for students who are, or will be, reading for an Oxford University graduate degree in October 2011 related to Jewish Studies (particular preference will be given to topics related to the history of the Holocaust). **Closing date: Friday 11 March 2011.**

Wilfrid Knapp Scholarship (Arts): one Graduate Scholarships of £5,000 per annum, tenable for up to three years whilst the recipient is liable for University and College fees, and is for students who are, or will be reading for an Oxford University research degree (DPhil, MLitt, or MSc by Research) in the Arts (Humanities Division and Social Science Division) in October 2010. **Closing date: Friday 11 March 2011.**

All the above Graduate Scholarships may be held in conjunction with an award from another body and carry entitlement to limited High Table dining rights. With the exception of the Light Senior Scholarships they also carry entitlement to up to two years' single accommodation in College or a College House (at the current room charge rate), which should be taken in the first two years of the scholarship.

The scholarships are open both to new graduate students commencing graduate study at Oxford in October 2011 and to current graduate students who will have completed no more than two years of graduate research degree study at Oxford in October 2011.

With the exception of the Light Senior Scholarships, students at other colleges are eligible to apply, but would need to migrate to St Catherine's to take up any of these scholarships if their application was successful.

Before awarding any Scholarship, the College must be satisfied that sufficient funding is available to cover all costs, including University and College fees and maintenance, for the full duration of the course. For the academic year 2011-12, the University estimates that a single student spending 12 months in Oxford, and in college accommodation or in private accommodation in a shared house, would need at least £12,300 to cover living expenses, excluding the cost of travel to and from Oxford.

There is no application form for any of these scholarships. Applicants should send a curriculum vitae with a covering letter including a research outline (where appropriate) and statement of other means of financial support to the Academic Registrar, St. Catherine's College, Oxford OX1 3UJ (Email: academic.registrar@stcatz.ox.ac.uk. Fax: +44 (0)1865 271768). **Please remember to specify the scholarship(s) for which you wish to apply.**
