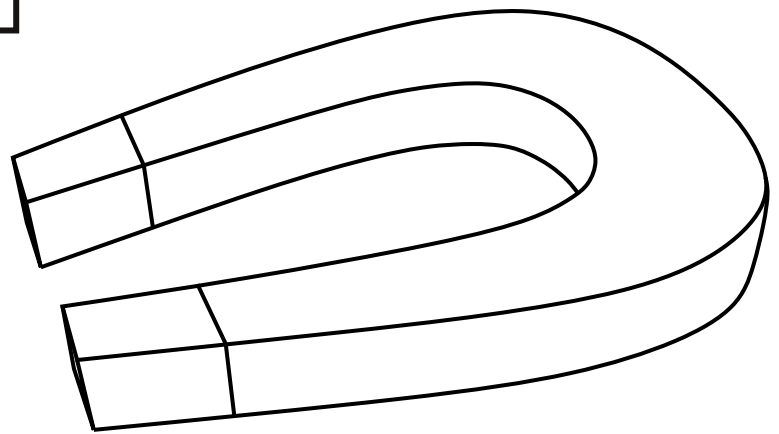
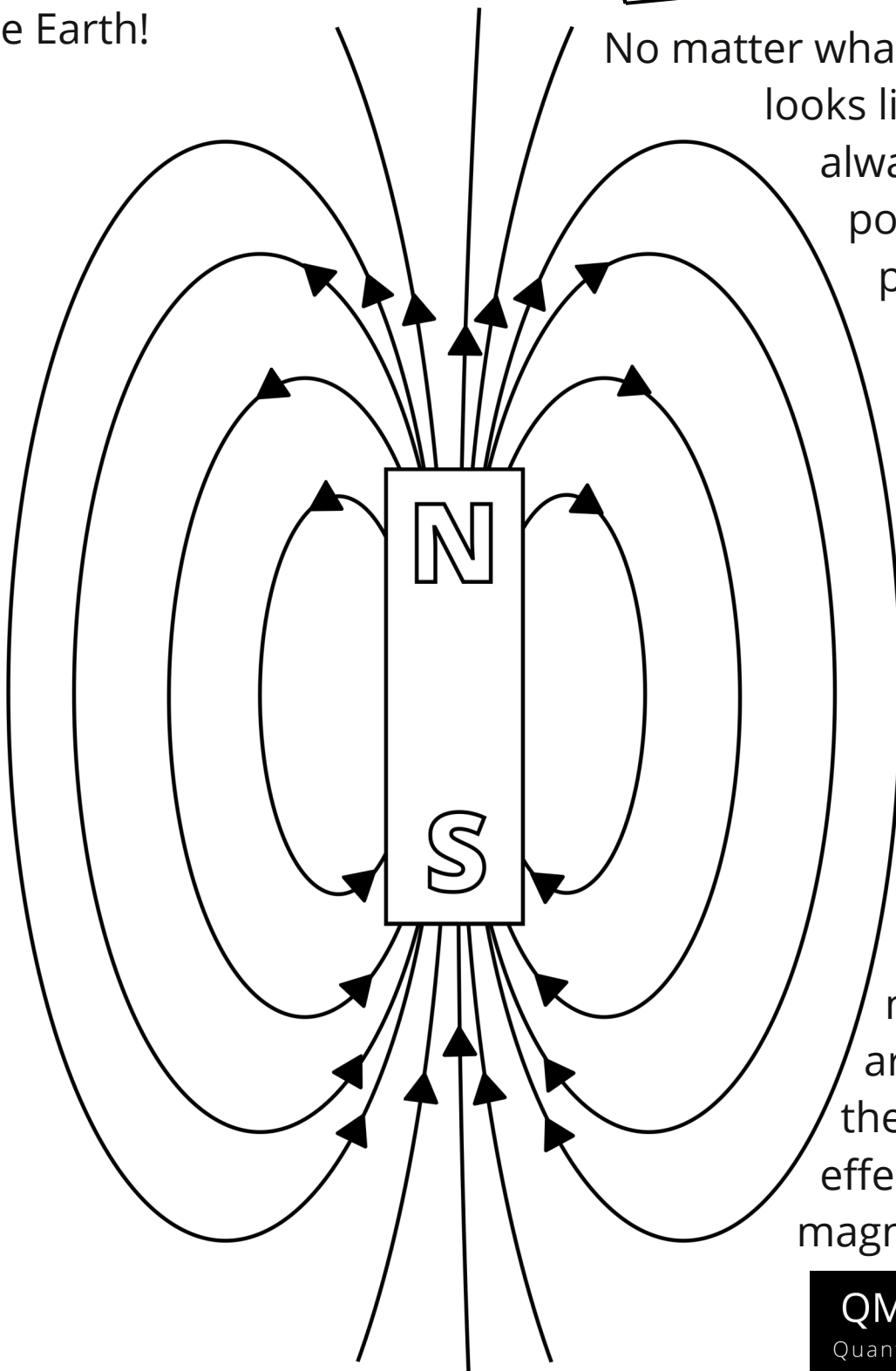


# Magnetism

We draw lines to show the "magnetic field". The more lines are in an area, the stronger the effect of the magnet is there.
