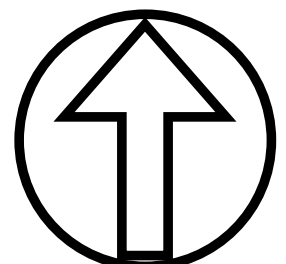
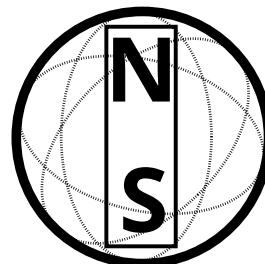
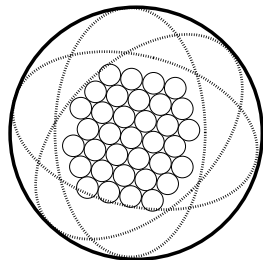
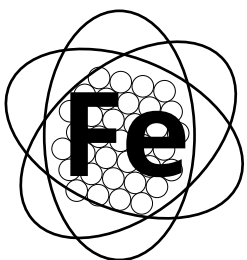


Ferromagnetism
